Re: Cannon Surety, LLC Appointees

The Bail Bond Regulatory Division of the North Carolina Department of Insurance wanted to inform all interested parties of changes affecting the appointed individuals with Cannon Surety, LLC. Pursuant to an Order issued by the Wake County Superior Court pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 58-30-65, effective Thursday September 28, 2017 at 10am (Eastern Daylight Savings Time), all individuals who are appointed to Cannon Surety, LLC **must cease and desist from becoming liable on any further bonds.**

Surety Bondsman are prohibited from writing any bonds on Cannon Surety, LLC powers.

Surety Bondsman are instructed to immediately submit weekly reports along with any unused powers and all premiums due to Cannon Surety, LLC to the North Carolina Department of Insurance. Send all powers and premiums (certified/cashier checks or money orders only, **NO CASH**) to:

Please note that consistent with all contractual and statutory requirements, Surety Bondsmen appointed by Cannon Surety, LLC, along with Cannon Surety, LLC, will continue to be responsible for **ALL** outstanding liabilities. Please note that if the only appointment you have is with Cannon Surety, LLC you are no longer authorized to write any bonds until you have obtained an appointment from another surety company.
