

Inactive Status

- (1) A licensee who has been placed on inactive status shall not engage in the business of performing home inspections for compensation.
- (2) All requests to be placed on inactive status must be made in writing to the Board.
- (3) A licensee must have an active license before he/she is eligible to be placed on inactive status.
- (4) A licensee who has been placed on inactive status is not subject to license renewal (i.e. Continuing Education hours or renewal fee) requirements during the period in which the licensee remains on inactive status.
- (5) A licensee who has been placed on inactive status may apply to the Board to be reinstated to active status at any time. The request to be reinstated to active status must be made in writing to the Board.
- (6) A licensee may be placed on inactive status for an indefinite period.
- (7) A licensee who applies to be placed on active status must pay the renewal fee for the current licensing year at the time the license is placed on active status.
- (8) To be eligible for reinstatement, a licensee must meet any continuing educational requirements by completing the same number of Continuing Education (CE) credit hours that would have been required for an active license during the period of the inactive license; but, not more than 24 credit hours.
- (9) A licensee who has been placed on inactive status is responsible for keeping the Board informed of his current address.
