**1 OF 4: RESCUE / REMOVING FIREFIGHTER  
WITH SCBA MALFUNCTION**

**NFPA 1001, 5.3.9(b)**

**Performance Objective:** The candidate, wearing full protective gear and SCBA, shall demonstrate conducting a primary search for a firefighter with a malfunctioning SCBA using one of the following methods and remove firefighter within 20 minutes of making entry into structure.

- a. With a hose line.
- b. Without a hose line.
- c. With a rope.
- d. Without a rope.

The evaluator shall select the method to be demonstrated.

The candidate shall select a forcible entry tool (ax) to bring into the structure.

**Performance Evaluation:** The evaluator shall use the Rescue Mannequin with an SCBA equipped with a buddy breathing connector to simulate a conscious firefighter. The evaluator should then find another person to assist the candidate with a two-person search. The candidate shall give all orders and directions during the course of the search. The candidate shall be evaluated on safe search techniques, search patterns and marking systems.

Working as a leader of a team, demonstrate using the buddy breathing connection system or rapid removal of the firefighter.

**Instructor statement:** Please demonstrate conducting a safe search in this structure utilizing the search method selected by the evaluator and demonstrate hooking up the buddy breathing connection and removing a firefighter whose SCBA has malfunctioned within 20 minutes of making entry into the structure.

**2 OF 4: RESCUE / REMOVING CIVILIAN  
WITHOUT RESPIRATORY PROTECTION**

**NFPA 1001, 5.3.9(a)**

**Performance Objective:** The candidate, wearing full protective gear and SCBA, shall demonstrate conducting a primary search for a firefighter with a malfunctioning SCBA using one of the following methods and remove firefighter within 20 minutes of making entry into structure.

- a. With a hose line.
- b. Without a hose line.
- c. With a rope.
- d. Without a rope.

The evaluator shall select the method to be demonstrated.

The candidate shall select a forcible entry tool (ax) to bring into the structure.

**Performance Evaluation:** The evaluator shall use the Rescue Mannequin to simulate an unconscious patient. The evaluator should then find another person to assist the candidate with a two-person search. The candidate shall give all orders and directions during the course of the search. The candidate shall be evaluated on safe search techniques, search patterns and marking systems. Working as a leader of a team, demonstrate using a two-person incline drag to rapidly remove the patient from the hostile environment.

**Instructor statement:** Please demonstrate conducting a safe search in this structure utilizing the search method selected by the evaluator and demonstrate removing a civilian from the environment, using the two-person incline drag method, within 20 minutes of making entry into the structure.

**3 OF 4: RESCUE / REMOVING CIVILIAN  
ONE RESCUER BLANKET DRAG**

**NFPA 1001, 5.3.9(a)**

**Performance Objective:** The candidate shall correctly demonstrate executing the steps for performing a one-rescuer blanket drag and move the patient to an area of safety within six minutes.

**Performance Evaluation:** The evaluator shall use the Rescue Mannequin to simulate an unconscious patient. The candidate shall be evaluated on his or her ability to correctly demonstrate the steps necessary to place the patient onto a blanket, secure the patient in the blanket and move the patient to a designated area of safety.

**Instructor statement:** Please demonstrate the steps needed to secure a patient in a blanket and safely move the patient to a designated area of safety within a time frame of six minutes.

**RESCUE / REMOVING CIVILIAN ONE RESCUER BLANKET DRAG**

**4 OF 4: RESCUE / REMOVING CIVILIAN  
TWO RESCUER SEAT LIFT / CARRY**

**NFPA 1001, 5.3.9(a)**

**Performance Objective:** The candidate, working as a member of a team, shall correctly demonstrate the steps needed to safely move a patient from out of harm's way using the Seat Lift/Carry method.

**Performance Evaluation:** The evaluator shall use the Rescue Mannequin to simulate an unconscious patient. The candidate shall be evaluated on his or her ability to correctly demonstrate the steps necessary to place the patient onto a blanket, secure the patient in the blanket and move the patient to a designated area of safety.

**Instructor statement:** Please demonstrate the steps needed to safely lift the patient using the Seat Lift/Carry method and move the patient to this chair, within a time frame of five minutes.
