**NFPA 1001, 6.5.4**

**Performance Objectives:** The candidate, given a portable power plant or portable lighting equipment used by the authority having jurisdiction, shall demonstrate any needed service or maintenance required due to the use of said equipment.

**Performance Evaluation:** The evaluator shall present the candidate with a portable power plant or portable lighting equipment used by the AHJ. The candidate shall be able to identify required service, preventative maintenance, and placing back in ready condition activities required before, during, and after use of the equipment.

**Instructor's Statement:** The candidate shall correctly describe and demonstrate the servicing and maintenance required for either the power plant or the lighting system used by the respective jurisdiction; then place the equipment in its appropriate storage location on the apparatus.

**Instructor's Statement:** The candidate shall correctly describe and demonstrate the operation of the selected hand and power tool, identify any pertinent safety hazards and return the tool to its storage location on the apparatus.
