

AUTOMOBILE LIABILITY

58-31-50. Liability insurance required for state-owned vehicles. Every department, agency or institution of the State shall acquire motor vehicle liability insurance on all state-owned motor vehicles under its control. (1959, c. 1248; 1983, c. 717, s. 10.)

Liability insurance is provided for all drivers of state-owned motor vehicles. The coverage is in the amount of \$1,000,000 bodily injury/property damage (\$10,000,000 aggregate per accident). The coverage is automatic and state agencies complete a self audit at the beginning of the physical year using the Department of Insurance web site.

AUTO PHYSICAL DAMAGE

Physical Damage insurance provides collision and comprehensive coverage for scheduled vehicles. State Agencies must individually schedule vehicles on the Auto Physical Damage policy for the desired coverage using the Department of Insurance web site.
